The cup to be held by the 1st Prize Band until One Month preceding the following September Contest, and to become the property of any Band winning the 1st Prize, at the September Contest, Three Years in succession.

THE "MUSICAL MAIL," 2 and 3, Arthur Street, New Oxford Street, London, W.C., will present a special prize to the winners of the 5th Prize.

GENERAL REGULATIONS.

Amateur Bands only allowed to play. All the performers must be members of the particular Band in which they are entered, and must not be selected from other Bands; the names and residences (in full) of the performers, and also of the Secretary and Conductor, must be inserted on the Form of Entry provided for the purpose; the name of the instrument upon which each performer will play must also be inserted; and no performer will be allowed to play during the Contest except upon the instrument entered opposite his name on the form of entry. All the players must have been members of the Band for three months previous to the Contest.

Any performer who, within six months of the date of the close of the entries, has been engaged as a regular member of the Band of any Theatre, or other public place of amusement or resort, will be considered a professional; and every performer must be in a position to prove, if required, that he is in some business or profession from which he derives his chief income, apart from the playing of music.

Every member of a Band must be resident in the town or within a distance of four miles, or thereabouts, of the town from which the Band is entered. Special remark must be made, and special permission obtained from Mr. Jennison, at the time of entry, before any member, whose residence is more than four miles distant, will be allowed to play. A player who is entered, and plays in a Band at the July Contest, will not be allowed to play in any other Band at the September Contest.

A Conductor may act for more than one Band, but will not be allowed to play in any Band.

A Professional Musician may be engaged as Conductor.

Trombones:—Slide Trombones only will be allowed to be used at this Contest.

No objection will be entertained as to a performer being a professional, or upon any other ground whatever (except in connection with the playing of the Music on the day), unless full particulars are forwarded at least one week previous to the Contest.

Mr. Jennison's decision will be final in all cases of dispute.

The Prizes will be awarded according to the decision of the Judges, and no appeal will be allowed therefrom, except where a Band is disqualified for an infringement of the rules. Where a Prize is withheld for a breach of the rules, such prize will be given to the next in order of merit.

Any Band disqualified will lose all claim to any Prize gained at the Contest, either by the Band or by any individual player, and will also be debarred from competing at any Belle Vue Contest the following year.

In competition for the Prizes, each Band must play the Grand Selection from VERDI'S OPERA, "La Traviata," selected and arranged for the Contest by CHARLES GODFREY, JUNR.
