# INSTRUCTIONS

#### FOR THE PROPER CARE OF

# BAND INSTRUMENTS.

In a new Instrument great care should be taken to keep it in all parts perfectly clean; the Slides carefully greased, and the Caps, Springs, and Water Key, in thorough working order. Top and Bottom Caps should be occasionally removed; if neglected and they stick, they should be loosened by a mallet lightly applied, never by pincers or tongs. The most important thing however are the Valves. Never, under any circumstance, put oil on the Valves. After being carefully cleaned, they should be well moistened with saliva, when they will respond readily to the touch, unless there be something radically wrong; if so, the fault is generally in the Springs. Weak or rusty Springs will cause no end of trouble, and when found defective, they should at once be replaced with a new set. Sometimes a little oil applied to the Spring will improve its action, and do away with the unpleasant grating sound often heard in even the best Instruments. The Slides should be removed and greased at least once in two weeks, using however, very little oil at a time. If this is neglected and they stick, soak in warm water and they can be readily removed. See that the Water Key is perfectly adjusted, and that no air can escape; it is death to a good Instrument if this is neglectd, or any other openings are allowed for the air to escape, except through its proper channel. It spoils the Tone and renders it hard to blow. If the loss of air is not the cause, and the Instrument has, lost its brilliancy of Tone, then look for an accumulation of grease or dirt. A fine sponge blown through the Instrument will remove this difficulty, and often change its Volume and Tone. proper Mouth Piece Box should always be used, as the habit of carrying a Mouth Piece loose in the pocket is sure to cause trouble, from dirt collecting and being blown into the Instrument.

Never, under any circumstances, file or scrape the Valves it is certain to ruin them. Be sure the water does not accumulate in the Instrument, as it tends to corrode and eat holes in the Valves. Another important matter is the Cork Padding for the Valves: if worn down or broken they will change slightly the length of the action, which is adjusted to a Mathematical nicety, and must be kept so, as otherwise it changes the air passage and spoils the Tone—To condense.

Never apply oil or grease to the Valves.

Never allow dirt or grease to accumulate.

Never file or scrape the Valves.


Never carry Mouth Piece loose in the pocket.

Never allow the Slides to corrode or stick.

Never lay the Instrument aside for any length of time without cleaning.

Never buy anything but the best, and then take the care of it that only a good Instrument deserves.




SHOWING WIND PASSAGE OF OPEN NOTES.
