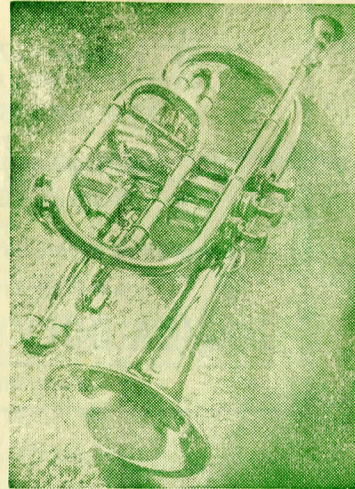


THE SUN NEVER SETS

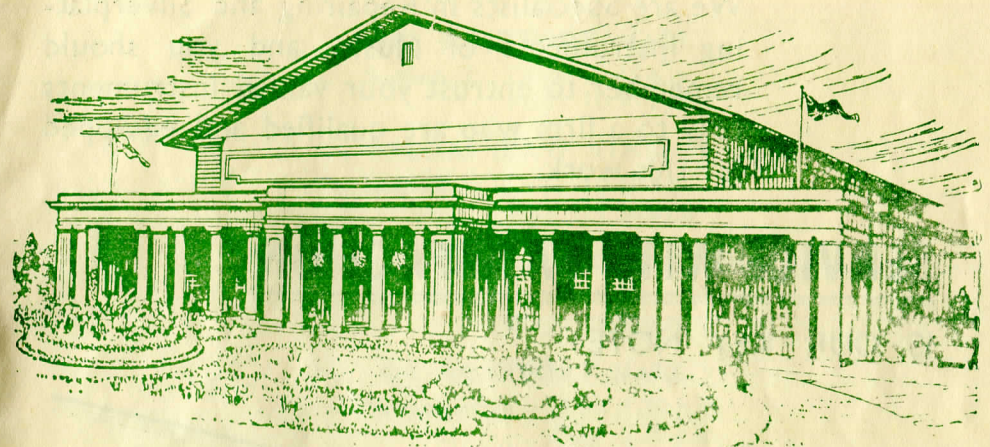
