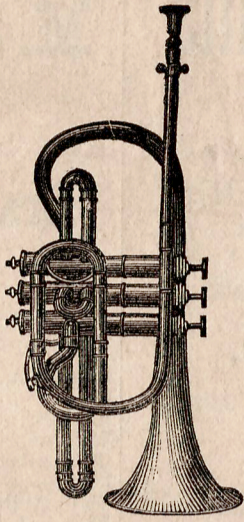

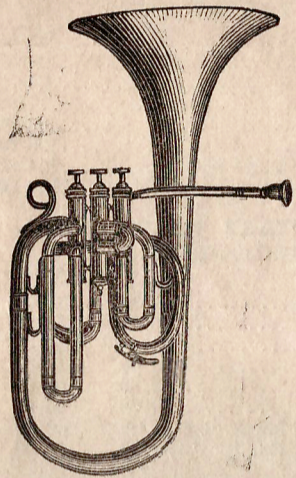

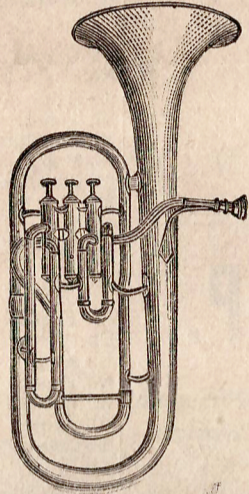


Bb CORNET, Arbuclle Model.

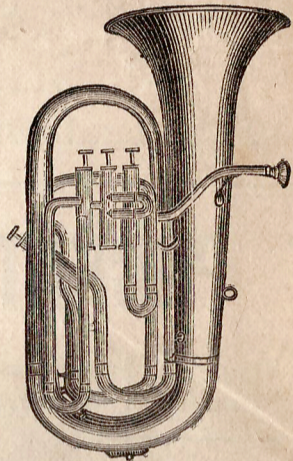

Bb Tenor.

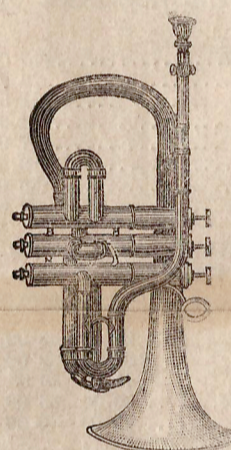


Bb Bass, (called Euphonium), with 4 Pistons, Light Valve.

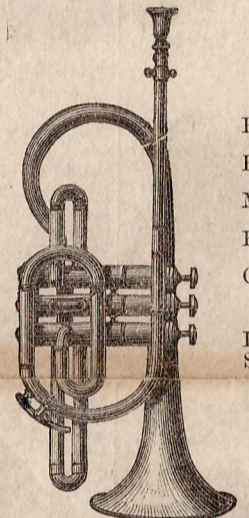

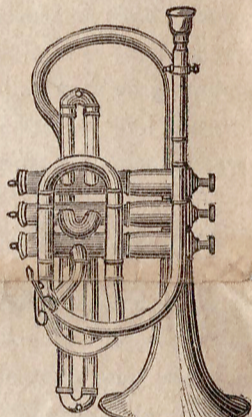
